Discussion Questions

1. Injustice is a concept that can be difficult to pin down because people have different opinions of what is right and wrong or appropriate and inappropriate. In your mind, what are some clear-cut examples of injustice in our world?
2. Contrary to popular opinion, anger does nothing to address injustice. When have you seen injustice addressed in a way that produced a solution or resolution?
3. One of the key points from this week's teaching is that anger clouds our judgment when we are attempting to deal with injustice. Where do you see examples of anger making problems worse in the world today? In your own experience?
4. Some people seem to have a natural ability to stay calm in every situation. Who has been an example in your life of remaining cool and confident even in the most difficult situation?
5. There is a great deal of confusion in the church today about the concept of forgiveness, as many believe that forgiving someone means pretending that everything is okay. What is a practical and biblical definition of what it means to actually extend forgiveness?
