Discussion Questions

1. Artists have a natural ability to look at something that seems rough on the surface and understand its true potential. In what ways is this like living an UnOffendable lifestyle?
2. Part of becoming unoffendable means no longer viewing forgiveness as a case-by-case option, but we forgive everyone. Who is someone in your life who has modeled this for you?
3. Living a lifestyle of forgiveness is counter-cultural. In your experience, what have been the biggest obstacles that have hindered you from viewing the world through the lens of radical forgiveness?
4. When you genuinely love people, you find it much easier to forgive their brokenness, and they find it much easier to let down their guard and connect with you. What does it mean on a practical level to "love" others? What does that look like in your life?
5. Behavior psychologists tell us that humans use their rationality to back up what they already believe, which is why it is so difficult to change another person's mind. How have you found this to be true? What is most effective in changing another person's mind?
