Discussion Questions

- 1. What do you recall was the Best. Gift. Ever. as a young person? What made it so great? Was it practical or impractical? Was it sparkly and shiny in a sense? Discuss what makes a gift the best.
- 2. Read John 1:1. The Son of God was called "The Word", using the Greek word "Logos". When the Logos spoke "words" or "logos" (small case), what did not exist came into being. What did Jesus create in vs. 3?
- 3. In John 1:14, the All-mighty Creator God became "flesh" and lived among us. The Son of God, Jesus Christ, a Person...also became a man. How is this Person himself, the Best. Gift. Ever.? See Romans 3:23, 6:23.
- 4. Isaiah 6:3 says "the whole earth is full of his glory". In what ways in creation and in our daily lives can we see and recognize His glory? In Genesis 1:3, God the Son said "Let there be light". How do you envision that light, when the sun, moon and stars had not yet been created?
- 5. Why do we put our hope in the glory of life's gifts that always fade away? What might our gifts to others reflect if we modeled our belief in the Christ-child as the Best, Gift, Ever.?
