Discussion Questions

1. The “normal” Christian life that unfolded for the Apostles and early Church in Acts 3:1-10 was truly Spirit-empowered. Why do you think such power is rare today?
2. When we’re consumed with our own felt needs, how does that hinder seeing the felt needs of others? Of being moved by the condition of people? Share a time where the Holy Spirit shined a spotlight on a felt need He prompted you to minister to.
3. The Holy Spirit had prepared a “divine appointment” for Peter and John that morning that required they recognize and give themselves to ministering to. What hinders us from recognizing and ministering to people and just plain missing such appointments?
4. Peter and John didn’t have a budget to minister to the lame man. What budget do you and I as Christ-followers have to minister from vs. 6? What is the value of “the Name”? Discuss why speaking with authority as an ambassador of the Name is so difficult?
5. By wholeheartedly obeying the Spirit’s prompting, we see an explosion of ministry in vs. 7-10. Read the passage and identify as many fruitful ministry outcomes you can. Close in prayer together, asking for every ministry gift needed in your coming week!
