Sermon Discussion Questions

- 1. Jesus is King over all Kings in Revelation 1:5-6, but it doesn't seem like He rules and reigns over all at times. How does His kingdom being upside-down make sense of this? Discuss.
- 2. We value traffic jams on the bridge to life. Read Mark 4:26-29 and discover together our role and God's role in expanding the kingdom.
- 3. We value kingdom saturation. What affect does yeast have on dough What affect like yeast does the King desire to have on us? Through us on the world? Why is that?
- 4. In Revelation 11:15, John writes that "the kingdom of the world will one day become...the kingdom of our Lord." In what ways has the King not yet saturated the world completely?
- 5. Share in closing one way the Holy Spirit may be asking you to ratchet up your role in sowing seeds, and one way He may be asking you to ratchet up your role in being saturated by the King and saturating the world?
