Discussion Questions

1. Nebuchadnezzar was “all over the map” in his life and spiritual journey. Share a time/season where you were too, and what that was like?
2. In vs. 1-3, “Neb” made quite a proclamation. Do you believe it was genuine, real faith and why? Daniel could have given up in frustration with Neb’s journey. What makes you want to give up on people? Discuss.
3. 2 Thessalonians 2:11-12 speaks of a powerful delusion. In what ways do you see this delusion today? How does it impact your loving people well? Do you write people off or love them relentlessly anyway?
4. Neb’s dream came when everything was going his way. Why is such a time in our lives so dangerous for us and others? How was God breaking in to his life and revealing himself? Have you seen it in others lives?
5. When people use “God talk” like Neb, but they return to their old ways, can you believe God is conditioning their hearts to turn to him? Can you lovingly wait patiently? Talk to Him about this together in prayer.
