Sermon Discussion Questions

- 1. All of us dream including Naomi. Make a list together of how many dreams you can think of that she might have dreamed for her life.
- 2. When our dreams meet real life, what reasoning and arguments do we use with ourselves and God about what He should do with our dreams? Colossians 1:4b-5a says our dreams are reserved where and why?
- 3. Whose dream were Elimelech and Naomi living? When the wheels started coming off the dream, how did they react. and what did they do? When your dreams run into real life, how have you reacted and acted?
- 4. It doesn't appear Elimelech and Naomi sought God for direction in the famine. Instead, they made an unwise decision. What poor choices have you made and why?
- 5. In vs. 3-5, how might you have reacted and acted when Naomi's dreams were being shattered and kind of ground into dust? What does that say to you about how you might want to view your dreams? God's dreams?
