3. Zechariah 4:10 tells us we are prone to not appreciate small things. What disciple-making roles have you viewed as insignificant? Why?
4. In 1 Corinthians 3:6-8, Paul describes numerous roles we can have in creating a greenhouse environment for growth in others. Share one or two ways your contribution has brought about such growth.
5. The small mustard seed when it grew, became a tree where birds could perch. In what ways might your life provide shelter, hope, wisdom, encouragement, etc. for others who might perch under your cover?
