Matthew 12:43-45; Romans 8:1-6

Sermon Discussion Questions

1. Many people are selective "Cleanies" who love a clean, swept home. From sharing your stories, what percentage of your group are Cleanies?
2. In Matthew 12:43-45, Jesus speaks of sweeping out impure spirits, referring to a larger need for keeping our spiritual lives swept and clean. If we don't keep our "house" swept, what's the danger we face? Discuss.
3. When we invite the Spirit to fill/control us (Eph 5:18), we end "neutrality" towards God & He seats Christ as King on the throne of our lives. Discuss the impact of neutrality vs. being filled & surrendered.
4. Read Romans 8:5-6. Our lives can be filled in two ways...discuss the way of the flesh and the way of the Spirit. How real is this struggle for you?
5. Share in a time of prayer, inviting the Holy Spirit to fill you to overflowing. In prayer, invite the Lord Jesus again to be your King, ruling and reigning over all your life. Thank God for this gift of life and peace!
