Sermon Discussion Questions

- 1. The Pharisees prayed to be seen and admired by people. What is effectual, fervent prayer in James 5:16b (KJV)? How is such prayer different?
- 2. Being devoted to prayer in Colossians 4:2 was likened to fuel being ignited, providing propulsion for a rocket. Why is God moved this way?
- 3. Why did Paul ask for prayer as he shared the Good News of the Gospel? See Colossians 4:3-4 and identify as many reasons as you're able.
- 4. The integrity of the messengers sharing the Gospel mattered to Paul in Colossians 4:5-6. Why is it crucial to intercede for the character of people in such circumstances? Discuss.
- 5. As a group, close your study time praying for yourselves and for one another, that as individuals and as a small group, your prayer lives would be ignited and propelled to Paul's level of effectual, fervent prayer.
