- 2. In Matthew 5:17 Jesus seamlessly bridged old school and new school. What was He saying about Himself?
- 3. In vs. 33-35, the Pharisees wanted Jesus to align with their pious lives of fasting, etc. His reply was about His presence. Discuss what this meant.
- 4. The garment Jesus wants us to "put on" habitually is what/who? Discuss. What does His Presence as a garment say to you personally? Why?
- 5. The wine Jesus wants us to habitually "put within" means what to you and your life as a disciple? What kind of disciples is he asking us to be and to make?
