1. In what ways would you consider yourself “Old-School” and “New-School”? How about as a disciple of Jesus Christ? Discuss.
2. In Matthew 5:17 Jesus seamlessly bridged old school and new school. What was He saying about Himself?
3. In vs. 33-35, the Pharisees wanted Jesus to align with their pious lives of fasting, etc. His reply was about His presence. Discuss what this meant.
4. The garment Jesus wants us to “put on” habitually is what/who? Discuss. What does His Presence as a garment say to you personally? Why?
5. The wine Jesus wants us to habitually “put within” means what to you and your life as a disciple? What kind of disciples is he asking us to be and to make?
