Sermon Discussion Questions

- 1. Share a time when authority and power were delegated to you and you poorly exercised it? Why was that? What did you learn from the event?
- 2. People in authority can exercise their power to do good or evil. What in our lives can cause us to do evil? To do good, but with wrong motives?
- 3. In Matthew 28:18, Jesus was authorized and empowered by the Father. In Luke 9:1-2 & Matthew 10:1, He delegated the same to the disciples. Was it without limits? What was the Spirit's role in unleashing power?
- 4. Acts 1:8 tells us under the covering of our authority (exousia), we would receive power (dunamis). What is the purpose of such power?
- 5. In what ways do we fail or succeed in exercising our power? Reference Matthew 10:7-8. What is the Spirit saying to the church/Parkside here?
