Discussion Questions

- 1. The law is a regular part of our lives. Describe a time when you were extremely grateful to be covered by a law and why. A time when you were not exactly grateful and why.
- 2. The levirate law of the kinsman-redeemer was created by God among many things, to redeem people out of bondage. What was the motivation that drove Boaz to take action? The first-in-line to take no action?
- 3. When the first-in-line kinsman-redeemer realized the transaction of buying the land included marrying Ruth, what went through his mind? Why?
- 4. Driven by love, Boaz was willing to pay whatever price to redeem Ruth to be his bride. In what way was/is Christ driven to do the same? Discuss.
- 5. Boaz paid an exacting legal price to redeem Ruth and Naomi. Jesus paid an exacting legal price to redeem you and me. How important was it and why that He fulfilled the law exactly in paying that price? Discuss.
