Sermon Discussion Questions

- 1. Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19. In any historical, global sense, most of us would be viewed as rich. Do you agree or disagree and why?
- 2. A baseline is a minimum starting point. Would you say you even have a baseline of giving? Would you say your baseline is a generous one? Discuss whether you are a robber of God or not.
- 3. If your baseline in generosity is keeping the law of God, what are the dangers you face in an age of grace?
- 4. How do you respond to the challenge to surrender your generosity baseline to the Holy Spirit's leading? Is it freeing? Frightening? Share how such a revolutionary choice might change your life & service?
- 5. In Acts 2:44-45, the early church modeled extravagant generosity (time, talent, treasure). Discuss the characteristics of that loving, disciplemaking community? Are you experiencing them in your life?
