### **Sermon Discussion Questions**

1. Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19. In any historical, global sense, most of us would be viewed as rich. Do you agree or disagree and why?
2. A baseline is a minimum starting point. Would you say you even have a baseline of giving? Would you say your baseline is a generous one? Discuss whether you are a robber of God or not.
3. If your baseline in generosity is keeping the law of God, what are the dangers you face in an age of grace?
4. How do you respond to the challenge to surrender your generosity baseline to the Holy Spirit's leading? Is it freeing? Frightening? Share how such a revolutionary choice might change your life & service?
5. In Acts 2:44-45, the early church modeled extravagant generosity (time, talent, treasure). Discuss the characteristics of that loving, disciple-making community? Are you experiencing them in your life?
