### **Sermon Discussion Questions**

1. When Jesus spoke words over the paralytic in Matthew 9, they were words of both healing and forgiveness. Share an experience from God's word where you felt Jesus spoke over you. How did it affect you?
2. When your walk with God the Father, your "Abba" is vibrant and alive, it can seem like "Face Time" today. Discuss how Covid has impacted that.
3. Jesus spoke words of forgiveness to all of us on the cross, as He made provision for that forgiveness. From Exodus 12:7, discuss the monumental importance of the application of that provision.
4. In Luke 23:34b, Jesus asked the Father to forgive us because we don't know what we're doing. Why did God provide forgiveness when none of us asked for it? See Romans 5:8.
5. How involved and engaged in this crazy world does God seem to you? Does that align with the truth of 2 Corinthians 5:19? Close in prayer with thanksgiving that God knows what He's doing at all times.
