Sermon Discussion Questions

- 1. Begin your time by sharing a story about "whose hands you trust" from your life experience and why? Why did you have faith in those hands?
- 2. In Luke 23:46, Jesus said "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." How many ways did Jesus trust His Father's hands from the triumphal entry to the cross? List them together.
- 3. As Jesus crossed from life to death as the Lamb of God in John 1:29, A. What was He trusting His life and death would accomplish?
 - B. ...that His Father would do for Him as the Roaring Lion? Why was all this so important for God and for us? Discuss.
- 4. In Romans 6:4-5, why is the substitute sacrifice of Jesus so important for us? Whose hands are you trusting when you die? To do what?
- 5. In John 19:28, Jesus finished everything God had planned for His life. Discuss what kingdom advancing work through your life...is unfinished. Pray for renewed courage to journey well this Easter season.
