Sermon Discussion Questions

- 1. People came to Jerusalem at Passover to "Get to God" but were often thwarted. Share a time when you felt thwarted trying to "Get to God".
- 2. John the Baptist said Messiah would make crooked paths straight in Luke 3:4-6. What makes our path crooked? How does he straighten it?
- 3. In John 2:14, the people were thwarted by scams that became obstacles for people trying to get to God. Describe what those scams were. Share and discuss scams/obstacles that have hindered you.
- 4. How did Jesus take action to remove the scams he saw in the temple? Did clearing those obstacles meet the real need or felt need of people?
- 5. What was Jesus referring to in vs. 21 that would not only meet the felt need of you and me, but their deep and lasting real need. What action did he take to straighten their crooked path...forever?
