Sermon Discussion Questions

- 1. Jesus engaged the Samaritan woman by following her lead in the conversation. In what ways do you lead and follow in conversation? What is most comfortable and why?
- 2. Conversations about God, Jesus and faith are uncomfortable for many. What makes it awkward for you? For others? Discuss the reasons.
- 3. How did Jesus move the conversation from surface/felt needs, to deeper real needs? Read Luke 12:11-12 in the Message for insight.
- 4. What Gifts of the Spirit (Galatians 5; Romans 12) might be helpful in engaging those you encounter on your journey? What might those gifts in motion, mean to the one you're engaging? Discuss.
- 5. 2 Timothy 2:23-26 describes how to engage without distraction. If it takes 7 Gospel conversations for faith to take root, how important is patience? How important is it to have subsequent conversations?
