Discussion Questions

1. The condition of physical and spiritual walls in our lives can be difficult to assess. Share a time when you struggled to honestly assess your walls and how their condition impacted you? Why was that so?
2. Nehemiah did a quiet night time inspection of the walls in Jerusalem. What did he see and what did he honestly discern about their condition and the condition of the people's hearts and minds? Discuss.
3. In vss. 17-18, Nehemiah made a bold case for the people to Arise and build. What trouble were they in and why? What was the significance of the burned gates? Why was this a disgrace to the people? Discuss.
4. Why is Nehemiah's testimony of what God had done through King Artaxerxes so powerful? How has God empowered you to rise up and build in your life? Share a testimony of God's abundance and provision.
5. How did Nehemiah respond to a second wave of resistance? How does God strengthen us to advance his Kingdom? To confront resistance?
