Sermon: Living a Deliberate Pace of Life
Esther 2:1-23

Sermon Discussion Questions

1. The pace of our lives is fast and moving faster. When you're moving at the fast pace you are, what do you miss? Discuss. Why don't you slow down? What parts of your life carry you along instead of the reverse?
2. The Westminster Catechism: "God's works of Providence are his most holy, wise and powerful...preserving and governing his creatures and all their actions." Are we where we are in this life by God's hand? Discuss.
3. In vs. 5-6, what made Mordecai's life unique, that God used to bring about redemption for his people? What about your unique life?
4. In vs. 7-8, Esther was swept into the King's selection process. Share her reactions and yours to God's Providential workings if this were you?
5. Why do you think God made Esther queen? Mordecai a hero? How did this work to redeem His people Israel? Why do you think he's positioned you where you are? Are you obediently submitting to His redemptive work through you?
