Nehemiah 1:1-4

Discussion Questions

1. Have two or three share a good reason for them to Rise up and Celebrate their family at Parkside Church over the last 50+ years. Pray a prayer of thanksgiving and praise together to God for His goodness!
2. Nehemiah challenged the remnant in Jerusalem to Rise Up and Rebuild the walls of Jerusalem. What good work (Nehemiah 2:18) have you strengthened your hand to build in recent memory? Share that work.
3. People are broken and their lives are in disarray all around us. Discuss why we often don't notice them, or find ourselves moved by their state.
4. In verse 4, Nehemiah responded to the broken walls in Jerusalem, but far more the bondage the people were in as slaves. Discuss the many forms of brokenness you see and are moved with compassion for?
5. What new work of building or rebuilding in your personal life, the lives of your loved ones or in your community is God nudging you to engage? Pray together and ask God to help you Rise Up and Build again.

- B. What did the Spirit tell you to DO about it?
