Sermon Discussion Questions

1. What percent of your lifetime has God seemed quiet or invisible? Why do you suppose it seems that way? What conclusions do you draw about God or you yourself as a result? Discuss.
2. In John 5:17, why do you suppose you don't see God at work? Do you have faith to believe He is always at work? Why or why not?
3. Israel's disobedience brought painful judgment from other nations. But God had promised to send the Messiah through them. What did this mean for God's people? What does it say about God?
4. God is not mentioned once in the story of Esther. From your knowledge of the story, share highlights where you see God at work.
5. From the story, how might Esther, Mordecai or any Jew answer these questions: God, are you here? God, do you care? God, can I trust you through these events for my good and your glory? Discuss how you might answer them.
