Sermon Discussion Questions

- 1. What percent of your lifetime has God seemed quiet or invisible? Why do you suppose it seems that way? What conclusions do you draw about God or you yourself as a result? Discuss.
- 2. In John 5:17, why do you suppose you don't see God at work? Do you have faith to believe He is always at work? Why or why not?
- 3. Israel's disobedience brought painful judgment from other nations. But God had promised to send the Messiah through them. What did this mean for God's people? What does it say about God?
- 4. God is not mentioned once in the story of Esther. From your knowledge of the story, share highlights where you see God at work.
- 5. From the story, how might Esther, Mordecai or any Jew answer these questions: God, are you here? God, do you care? God, can I trust you through these events for my good and your glory? Discuss how you might answer them.
