Sermon Discussion Questions

1. Leprosy made you an untouchable in Jesus day. Share 2 examples of a circumstance where you felt like a leper and untouchable and why.
2. Being a Leper was a life-long condition. What kind of conditions might people suffer in today making them miserable, numb and desperate? Consider the physical, emotional, spiritual, psychological, etc.
3. The Leper violated the law and boldly approached Jesus. What posture did he take and what made him so aggressive? What steps might you take if you were in a similar condition and had been for a long time?
4. How important is touch to our well-being? How important might our touch be for an untouchable "leper" today? Do you believe healing could flow through your touch? Why or why not?
5. What's keeping you from anointing, laying on your hands (touching) and praying for healing for others in your group or family? If it's invited, why not reach out and touch someone, asking God for a gift of healing.
